DU students submit memo to V-C today

'Students Against Repression' will submit a memorandum to the acting Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University today (Saturday) demanding reopening of the university by August 24, punishment to those responsible for attacking the students of Shamsunnahar Hall, withdrawal of security personnel from the campus and amendment of proctorial rule.

The students, who too are demanding withdrawal of false cases against the students, vowed to wage a tougher movement if the university is not reopened by August 24, and their other demands are not met, says a press release.

The students urged all students to take part in today's (Saturday's) programme that also include gathering of students in front of Rokeya Hall of the university at 11 am.
