## Pry. teachers' institute smarts under problems

MOULVIBAZAR, July 9.—The Primary Teachers Training Institute (PTI) Moulvibazar has been smarting under various problems. Shortage of teachers, dilapidated condition of doors and windows, and bad condition of sanitary system in all the latrines and bathrooms of the hostels have been causing sufferings

to the students.

There are 15 posts of teachers but now the institute is running with only 5 teachers including the Superintendent of this Institute. Besides there is no clerk in the office.

The doors and windows are being damaged. Sanitation equipments in the bathroom and latrines went out of order as a result of which trainees residing in the hostels have been suffering a lot and it may cause health hazards.

### Budget '87-88

The annual budget of Moulvibazar Pourashava for the fiscal year of 1987-88 was passed at a meeting of the elite of the town including the Commissioners of Pourashava held at the premises of Pourashava Office on July 5. Mr. Ali Haidar Khan, Divisional Commissioner Chittagong and Mr. Rezwan Uddin, Deputy Commissioner Moulvibazar were present in the meeting as chief and special guests respectively.

The budget proposed a total income of Taka 95.81.323 which proposed a total expenditure of Taka 95.25.451 for the development works in different sectors which include roads, drainage, education, health and sanitation etc.

Mr. Syed Mohsin Ali Chairman Moulvibazar Pourashava spoke on the occasion and discussed at length on various aspects of the budget

and called for Government assistance to fulfil the development programmes proposed in the budget.

Mr. Ali Haidar Khan speaking as chief guest congratulated the Pourashava authority for placing the budget publicly, which will fill up the gaps between town dwellers and Pourashava authority with good relations and understanding.

He also called upon the town dwellers to pay their arear taxes and enjoy all sorts of possible facilities provided by the Pourashava.

The meeting was rounded off with a light tea party.
