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Upgradation of college absolves govt. duty?

MAULVIBAZAR, Aug. 11—The Maulvibazar Government College has been smarting under various problems. The college established in 1956 was upgraded into government college in 1980. It has now a roll strength of 1520 students.

In the college buildings including class rooms, commonroom and administrative buildings more than 100 cracks have developed in the walls and ceiling of the buildings. During the last HSC examination some students were injured when some portions of cracked ceiling of the building fell on them.

The Engineers of the Local Facilities Department declared all the buildings including the administrative one of the college are abandoned long ago. The Arts Building of the college damaged during the War of Liberation have not yet been re-constructed resulting in acute accommodation problem in the college and the matter was brought to the notice of the authorities concerned several times.

Besides the college lacks recreational facilities. The college is facing shortage of teachers. It has no auditorium. Paucity of pure drinking water, lack of science equipments, absence of fans and latrine are causing untold sufferings to the students.

There are 64 posts of the teachers in the college but now the college is running with only 29 teachers. There is no library room and books are kept in a small room of a cracked building. The student common room is now under lock and key due to its dilapidated condition.

The existing latrines of the college have been damaged long before. There is no tubewell or water supply in the college.

The college authority has submitted proposals to the authorities concerned for the solution of the problems but nothing has been done in this respect.

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
