Cricket victory**DU still in a festive mood**

The celebration sequence of Bangladesh Cricket team's victory over Pakistan is still persisting here on Dhaka University campus which made the atmosphere a festive one in the wake of overall jubilation and especially on the eve of national welcome to the cricketers.

The Celebration Committee of socio political bodies sacrificed five cattle on the occasion on Wednesday night whereas the number of cattle sacrificed was one on the occasion of Bangladesh's first ever victory over Scotland in the World Cup a few days back.

It was the second phase of cattle sacrifice. Earlier, on Tuesday Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) sacrificed another cattle and held a feast.

On the second day of the three-day celebration by the Celebration Committee on Wednesday a discussion meeting and cultural function was held at the Teachers, Students Centre (TSC) premises.

The meeting was addressed by the Convener of the Celebration Committee Golam Kuddus, Joint Convener Kamal Pasha Chowdhury, noted cultural personality Ramendu Majumdar and General Secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League Ajay Kar Khokon.

Later at night, the committee held a feast at TSC after sacrificing three cows and two goats.
