Film festival begins at DU tomorrow

Face of Bangla in Cinema, a film festival begins tomorrow (Saturday) at the Dhaka University TSC auditorium.

The Dhaka University Film Society (DUFS) is organising the festival to mark the 50 years of historic Language Movement where some 16 Bangla feature films will be exhibited.

Well appreciated Bangla films—Mukh O Mukhosh, Nadi O Nari, Kancher Deaal, Asia, Saréng Bou, Megher Onek Rang, Surja Dighal, Bari, Chhutir Ghanta, Basundhara, Titas Ekti Nadir Nam, Dumurer Phool, Surjasnan, Lathial, Emiler Goenda Bahini, and 13 No. Feku Ostagar Lane—will be exhibited in the five-day festival, organisers said at a Press conference on Thursday.

Language veteran Abdul Matin will open the festival. Noted filmmakers—Abdus Samad, Sheikh Niamat Ali and Morshedul Islam—will also address the inaugural session.

On the second day a seminar on 'My Film In My Language' will be held at the Goethe Institute.

The gate passes of the festival will be available in front of the TSC Auditorium before the shows.
