57 Pry. teacher posts vacant in Rajbari

RAJBARI, Jan. 25: As many as 57 posts of primary school teacher have been lying vacant for a long time in all the four upazilas of the district hampering the implementation of Universal Primary Education Programme. Official sources said, of the total posts, 12 are of Headmasters and the remaining 45 are the Assistant Teachers.

It may be mentioned here that there are 261 government primary schools and 55 private schools in the districts. A total of 73556 students read in the government primary schools while 7052 students read in the private schools.

The upazilawise vacant posts are 10 Rajbari sadar, 16 in Pangsa, 26 in Baliakandi and 5 in Goalundo upazila.

Besides, the primary schools which were damaged by floods and storms during the last few years have not yet been repaired. Roofs of 30 school buildings are in a dilapidated condition and tin-roofs of 47 schools have been severely damaged.

According to informed source, the quota of teachers in government primary schools, in the district are

not maintained properly. Some schools with a large number of students have been facing problem due to shortage of teachers while many schools having no requisite number of students have excess teachers

Rangamati

Our Rangamati correspondent writes: The dilapidated condition of about 23 primary school buildings has been hampering the education in Rangunia Upazila of Chittagong district.

Besides, shortage of teachers and furniture has been prevailing.

According to report, the authority did not take up measures to repair the school buildings. As a result, the education of the children has been affected.

Most of the schools have no furniture. Many of them are holding classes under the open sky.

According to official sources, 29,360 students are studying in 108 primary schools including 16 non-government in this upazila.

The guardians of students are worried over the situation. The problem needs immediate solution.
