Meritorious students of Chittagong given scholarships

CHITTAGONG, Dec. 29:— The Chattagram Kalyan Foundation which came into being in 1989 has so far distributed Taka 27,600 among 21 meritorious students and sportsmen, reports BSS.

Taka 1800 were given to each of the four students of the Chittagong University and Taka 1200 to each of the 13 students in different colleges and the same amount of money was given to each of the 4 sportsmen in Chittagong district.

The Chattagram Kalyan Foundation headed by Deputy Commissioner of Chittagong Mr. A.R. Khan was established with the objectives of awarding scholarships to meritorious students, bright sportsmen, litterateurs, artists, investors, cultural and social workers for the outstanding contributions in their respective fields.

The fund is created out of the contributions from union parishads, upazila parishad, Chittagong City Corporation and voluntary donations of the philanthropists and institutions.

The foundation will also establish a library under the name of "Chattagram Kalyan Foundation Library" and undertake promotional sports and cultural activities in Chittagong district.
