

DU to issue show cause notice to five students

Dhaka University authorities on Saturday decided to issue show cause notice to five students for their involvement in terrorist activities in two separate incidents, reports UNB.

The authorities also formed two inquiry committees comprising three-member to probe the incidents.

The students have to submit their reply to the notices within seven days, otherwise the show cause notices would be treated as temporary expulsion orders, said a DU press release.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the university officials with Pro-VC Prof. Shahadat Ali and Provosts of Jashimuddin, Mohsin, Shahidullah and AF Rahman Halls on Saturday afternoon.

The students against whom show cause notice will be issued included Neamul Islam Dablu and Ehsan, first year (old) student of International Relations, and Murad, first year (old) student of Political Science, centering AF Rahman Hall incident.

Two rounds of gunshots were fired on Friday in the hall centering the allotment of a seat.

The inquiry committee to investigate the incident of AF Rahman Hall is headed by hall provost Prof Harunur Rashid. Other members are: Dr Nur-Un-Nabi, Proctor, and a house tutor of the hall.

The authorities will also issue notice to Zakir, third year student of Management and resident of Mohsin Hall (room-343) and Asif, third year student of Political Science and resident of the same hall for attacking Kamal Hossain, a student of MA final year of Philosophy, in front of DUS snack shop.

The second inquiry committee was headed by DU Proctor. Other members are: Dr Khairul Hossain, Provost of Mohsin Hall and a house tutor of the hall.
