



8 Regional DDs offices now in Edn Dept

The Government has constituted eight regional deputy director's offices in the Education Department in place of the existing four divisional offices, reports Bss.

This will facilitate smooth functioning of the educational institutions, proper inspection and proper distribution of grants for the teachers employees of private schools, colleges and madrasahs of the country, an official press release said on Sunday. The new regional offices are: Dhaka, Mymensingh, Chittagong, Comilla, Rajshahi, Rangpur, Barisal and Khulna.

Dhaka region comprises Dhaka, Narayanganj, Manikganj, Munshiganj, Gazipur, Narsingdi, Rajshahi and Faridpur while Mymensingh region comprises Mymensingh, Ki-

shoreganj, Netrakona, Jamalpur, Sherpur and Tangail.

Chittagong Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, Bandarban, Khagrachari, Noakhali, Feni and Laximpur districts fall under Chittagong region while Comilla, Brahmanbaria, Chandpur, Sylhet, Habiganj, Maulavi-bazar and Sunamganj districts fall under Comilla region.

The Rajshahi regional office will cover Nawabganj, Naogaon, Natore, Bogra, Jaypurhat, Pabna and Serajganj while Rangpur region includes Rangpur, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Nilphamari, Lalmonirhat, Dinajpur, Takurgaon and Panchagarh districts.

Barisal, Pirojpur, Jhalakathi, Bhola, Patuakhali, Barguna, Gopalganj, Shariatpur and

Madaripur districts fall under the Barisal regional office while Khulna, Jessore, Narail, Jhenaidah, Magura, Kushtia, Meherpur, Chaudanga, Satkhira and Bagerhat districts are in the Khulna region.

The reconstituted regional offices will come into effect from January 31, 1987, the press release said.
