

Form new curriculum committee

Education minister tells officials

Education Minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon yesterday asked officials to form a new curriculum committee and complete member selection within this month to meet the 2027 target.

He said the process should begin next week and directed concerned authorities to take swift and coordinated steps to prepare the syllabus within the stipulated timeframe.

The minister made the remarks at a views-exchange meeting organised by the directorate of Madrasa Education at its conference room in the capital.

Milon said the education ministry is not a conventional administrative ministry but a fundamental nation-building institution that shapes the country's future and prepares the next generation.

He stressed the need to remove unnecessary red tape from the education system, according to a press release issued by the ministry.

At the same meeting, State Minister for Education and Primary Education Bobby Hajjaj sought specific and practical solutions from stakeholders to address challenges in the education sector.

He said a structured “solution list” should be prepared and submitted to the ministry, covering issues related to the responsibilities of the madrasa board and related directorates, teacher-related problems, coordination with universities and other institutions, and existing administrative complications.

Such a list would help ensure effective discussion and quicker decision-making, he added.
