

# 3 DU teachers suspended over July role

The Dhaka University authorities have suspended three teachers accused of supporting the Awami League and threatening students during the July uprising in 2024.

They are: Prof Shibli Rubayat-Ul-Islam of the Department of Banking and Insurance; Dr Nazmul Ahsan Kalimullah of Department of Public Administration; and Prof AKM Jamal Uddin of the Department of Sociology.

The syndicate also relieved two other teachers of academic duties on a temporary basis -- Prof Mohammad Azmal Hossain Bhuiyan of the Department of Botany over his alleged involvement in incidents related to the July uprising; and Tashrik-i-Habib, who gained attention on social media for his musical performances.

Sources said the syndicate approved a recommendation from the academic committee of the Bangla Department to remove Tashrik from academic activities over allegations including tarnishing DU's image through his activities on social media.

In addition, former Chhatra League leader and DU deputy registrar Lovlu Molla Shishir was suspended over his alleged controversial role during the July uprising.
