

Strike observe at DU

A student strike called by opposition student alliance Chhatra Sang Parishad was observed peaceful Dhaka University (DU) yesterday.

Very few students entered campus on the day as no academic activities were held.

The Sangram Parishad led main opposition Awami League student front Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and seven other opposition student bodies called the strike protesting an 'appointment of a teacher at the Department of General Engineering and Biotechnology recently.'

The student alliance consists of the BCL, Chhatra League (JSC), Jatiya Chhatra Dhara, Chhatra Oil Chhatra Moitri, Chhatra Kendra and Chhatra Samity.

They took out a procession and held a rally on the DU campus in support of the strike.

Meanwhile, ruling BNP's student front Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) also took out a procession and held a rally protesting the strike at educational institutions.

The alliance leaders on September 4 met Vice-chancellor Prof SMA Faiz and requested him to finalise the appointment of Shahnoor Hossain, who was involved in what they said illegal activities.

However, the university syndicate finalised the appointment on September 5 saying that there were no anomalies in appointment of Shahnoor.
