

Govt college lecturers strike from tomorrow

Government college lecturers will begin work stoppage for indefinite period across the country, excepting colleges under Comilla Board, from tomorrow (Monday) to press their 12-point demand, reports UNB.

The strike in colleges under Comilla Board will, however, start from October 10.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the central executive committee of the Government College Lecturers' Association in Dhaka yesterday.

The demands include filling 6,000 vacant posts of lecturer in government colleges, creation of 3,000 new posts and promotion of college teachers.

Office bearers of the association, including its President Kamal Ataur Rahman, Senior Vice-President AKM Muhammad Sanaullah and General Secretary Omar Faruque, were present at the meeting.

Classes will not be held and activities regarding admission, including distribution of admission forms, will remain suspended. HSC practical examinations and written test for admission into army will be exempted from the strike programme.
