

RUCSU GS names 161 'pro-fascist' teachers

Rajshahi University Central Students' Union general secretary Salahuddin Ammar published a list of 161 university teachers, accusing them of opposing the July Uprising of 2024 and supporting the fascist regime of Sheikh Hasina.

He disclosed the names at a press conference held at the university's Senate Building on Sunday afternoon.

Earlier on the day, Ammar attempted to announce the list while exchanging views at a meeting organised jointly by the Rajshahi University administration and the University Grants Commission to raise awareness among teachers and students about the referendum.

Vice-chancellor Professor Saleh Hasan Naqib, however, stopped him during the programme and asked him to submit the list to the university administration instead.

At the subsequent press conference, Ammar alleged that the teachers named in the list had financed opponents of the July movement, shaped narratives against it, taken positions hostile to student protesters and facilitated police action against demonstrators, among other allegations.

He announced a fresh protest programme, saying that students would stage a sit-in outside the Academic Council meeting scheduled for February 5, demanding disciplinary actions against the accused teachers.

‘If no decision is taken in that meeting to bring these 161 teachers to justice, we will not allow the meeting to conclude,’ he said.

Ammar also called on the university students to join him even for the last time to ensure trial of what he described as Awami fascists.
