

3 DU students suspended over harassment of two women

THREE students of Dhaka University have been suspended for six months over their involvement in the harassment of two women at the university's TSC area in the early hours of February 24.

The action was taken following the recommendation of an investigation committee formed over the incident, said a press release issued by the university's public relations office on Tuesday.

Exercising the authority vested in him under the Dhaka University Order, DU proctor professor Saifuddin Ahmed issued the suspension order, the press release added.

The suspended students are Shahriar Islam Tushar of the Theatre and Performance Studies department; Rakib Ahmed of the World Religions and Culture department; and Shahriar Tanjil of the Anthropology department.

Around 3:30am on February 24, two women were harassed when they came with their two male friends and stood near the Raju Sculpture after having sehri from Old Town of Dhaka.

Later, the male companions submitted a written complaint to the university's proctor office.
