## 11 invigilators, 2 centre secretaries relieved from duty

Eleven teachers on Wednesday were released from all their duties as invigilators for the ongoing Secondary School Certificate examinations over negligence of duty.

On the same day, two exam centre secretaries were also released from their duties over the same reason.



The Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dhaka sent letter to the Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education to take departmental actions against the accused.

The board on Wednesday issued five notices in these regard.

As per one of the notices, on Wednesday, the first day of the examinations, exams were held at nine centres of Sonargaon upazila in Narayanganj.

During the distribution of creative questions at the Kanchpur Omor Ali High School centre, the 2025 questions were provided to 177 regular examinees of 2026 from the Dhaka board.

The centre secretary noticed the incident one hour and 25 minutes after the start of the examination at 11:55am and distributed the 2026 question paper following advice of the Dhaka board controller of examinations.

Time for the 177 candidates was also extended accordingly to make up the time gap.

Following Article 15 of the 'Secondary School Certificate Examination Conduct Guidelines 2026', Kanchpur Omor Ali High School centre secretary Abdul Matin Sarkar is relieved of all responsibilities related to the centre secretary and examinations, the notice added.

Another notice read that centre secretary Md Mizanur Rahman of Rampura Ekramunnessa Boys' High School in Dhaka city was relieved of all responsibilities related to the centre secretary and examinations due to negligence of duty.

The SSC and its equivalent examinations began on Tuesday.

The 11 relieved invigilators are—Sheyuli Akhter (Kanchpur Omor Ali High School), Farzana Hossain Swapna (Sonar Bangla High School), Monowara Begum, Rownaq Ara Begum and Anisur Rahman (Panchami Ghat High School), Sumaiya Azad (Sonargaon Ideal School), Mosharraf Hossain (Sayda Khatun Islamia Dakhil Madrassah), Badrun Nahar Eva (Ali Akbar High School and College), Moniruzzaman (Sadipur High School), Sanoar Begum (Meghna Industrial City School and College), and Abdul Hamid (Jampur Majher Char High School).
