The biomedical physics and technology department of Dhaka University and the BYBIT Limited jointly held a workshop titled Foot Pressure Scan to Prevent Diabetic Amputation at the Curzon Hall of DU on Sunday.

DU pro-vice-chancellor, academic, Professor Abdus Salam inaugurated the workshop as chief guest, said a press release.



Dean of the faculty of science Professor Md Mofazzal Hossain spoke as special guest while BYBIT president and biomedical physics and technology department honorary professor Khondkar Siddique-e-Rabbani delivered welcome address at the workshop, which was presided over by chairperson of the department KM Talha Nahiyani.

Rashedul Islam of BIRDEM Hospital and CRP's SM Imran Shoaib gave presentations on the use of technology to prevent diabetic amputation.

Professor Abdus Salam said that the benefits of the dynamic pedograph device should be brought to the doorsteps of the common people. 'Everyone should work from their respective positions to create public awareness about the use of this device.'

Thirty-eight medical staff from various hospitals and institutes participated in the workshop.

The department of biomedical physics and technology invented a modern computerised dynamic pedograph device at a low cost in 2010 to prevent the amputation of the entire foot or finger of a patient due to diabetes.
