## DU Day to be celebrated on July 1

Dhaka University Day will be celebrated on July 1, marking the commencement of the university's academic activities on July 1, 1921.

Preparations for the celebration were reviewed at a meeting held on Monday at the Professor Abdul Matin Chowdhury Virtual Classroom on the campus in the capital, said a press release.



The meeting was presided over by DU vice-chancellor Professor ABM Obaidul Islam. Among others, DU pro-vice-chancellor for administration Professor Mohammed Almujaaddade Alfasane, pro-vice-chancellor for academic Professor Abdus Salam, treasurer Professor M Jahangir Alam Chowdhury and members of various sub-committees attended the meeting.

This year's theme is 'Dhaka University in restoration of democracy and higher education'.

According to the programme schedule, teachers, students, officers and employees will gather at Smriti Chirantan Chattar adjacent to the vice-chancellor's building at 9:30am on July 1. A colourful procession, led by the VC, will begin at 9:45am and conclude at Payra Chattar in front of the Teacher-Student Centre.

The national flag, along with the flags of Dhaka University and its residential halls, will be hoisted at 10:00am. The national anthem and the inaugural song will also be played.

A discussion meeting will be held at the TSC auditorium at 10:30am under the chairmanship of the VC.

A special commemorative plaque will be released and decorative arches will be erected at various university entrances to mark the occasion.
