## IU bans political activities for indefinite period

THE authorities of Islamic University in Kushtia on Monday banned all kinds of political activities on the campus for an indefinite period.

The decision was made at an emergency meeting of the proctors' body.

According to the decision, the ban on all political activities, including procession,

meeting and rally, would remain into effect until further notice. It also prohibited outsiders to come on the campus.

There had been unrest between two groups of teachers of Bangabandhu parishad on the campus over the last several days. The two groups of teachers, one led by vice-chancellor Prof Abdul Hakim Sarker and another led by pro-vice-

chancellor Prof M Shahinnoor Rahman, announced separate programmes on Monday morning.

IU proctor Prof M Mahbubar Rahman told New Age that they banned all kinds of political activities to avert any untoward situation on the university campus.

Additional police had also been deployed on the campus on Monday, he added.
